## Yukon Supplementary Allowance

If you receive or are eligible to receive Social Assistance, you may also be eligible to receive the Yukon Supplementary Allowance (YSA).

You can qualify for the YSA in two ways:

- you are 19 years of age or over and are found, through an assessment process, to be unemployable for a minimum of one year, by reason of a severe and prolonged disability; or
- you are a person who receives Old Age Security or who has reached the age of eligibility for Old Age Security.

If you qualify for the YSA you will receive \$250 per month in addition to your Social Assistance benefits.

In addition, if you receive the YSA, income from employment up to \$3900 per year will not be included in the calculation of your income.
