# Yukon Children's Dental Program

**The Yukon Children's Dental Program is a school-based public dental health program that provides diagnostic, preventative and restorative dental services to Yukon children. Dental therapists and dental hygienists provide dental services to both urban and rural communities.**



## Eligibility

Pre-school children, home-schooled children (to age 14) and students from Kindergarten to Grade 8 are eligible for services from the Yukon Children's Dental Program in Whitehorse and rural communities with a resident dentist.

Pre-school children, home-schooled children (to age 18) and students from Kindergarten to Grade 12 are eligible for services from the Yukon Children's Dental Program in communities **without** a resident dentist.

## Enrollment

Parents are required to complete the **Consent for Examination** form annually. Children are eligible to receive:

- ▶ Dental examination
- ▶ Diagnostic x-ray films (if required)
- ▶ Oral hygiene instruction
- ▶ Cleaning and/or scaling of teeth
- ▶ Fluoride application

## Examination

The initial dental examination is performed by a dentist who will also complete a recall examination every two years. In alternate years, the examination will be conducted by a dental therapist.

Dental exams for pre-school and home-schooled children are offered on a monthly basis at 9010 Quartz Road. Appointments can be made by calling 667-8360.

## Treatment

If your child requires dental treatment following the dental examination, a **Consent for Treatment** will be sent home to inform you of your child's dental needs and to obtain your written consent.

Treatment cannot be provided without written consent from the parent/guardian. Once this has been provided, your child will then receive the dental treatment prescribed, which may include:

- ▶ Fillings (silver amalgam)
- ▶ Composite resins (white fillings)
- ▶ Stainless steel crowns (on baby teeth)
- ▶ Pulpotomies (baby teeth)
- ▶ Extractions if required
- ▶ Emergency dental services

## Parent/Guardian Meetings

Scheduled meetings may be arranged with the dental therapist or dental hygienist to discuss your child's dental health concerns.
