**POLICY:**


For approved requests, Insured Health Services will make the initial purchase of a bed and mattress set.


Replacement of the mattress after the initial purchase will be the responsibility of the client.

Repairs will be the responsibility of the client if they are deemed to be the result of inappropriate use of equipment. Otherwise, repairs of the bed frame will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Any bed and mattress set purchased by Insured Health Services for use by an eligible client remains the property of the Government of Yukon.

All other policies related to replacement, ownership, and depreciation of equipment provided through the Chronic Disease Program and/or the Seniors Program shall apply.
